Program Schedule & Hours:

Due to the nature of the program we have built, we will need all participants on the same schedule. See the hours below:

Monday - Friday: 8:30am – 5:30pm (a lunch hour is included in the hours already)

Dress Code:

We would like comfortable attire, but keep it casual. Just no holes or tears in your clothing.

Computer Use:

Knowing most developers have specific programs and tools already downloaded and setup for use on their personal machine, we feel it would be best if you brought your own computer during the internship. If you do not have a machine to use, it is your responsibility to reach out to have one requested one month prior to the start date.

Pay Days & Time Sheets:

During this program, you will be paid at the end of each week. We will require time sheets to be filled out and submitted at the end of each week.

Parking Info:

El Toro will provide a \$30 credit to each person to assist with parking costs. There are multiple options for parking, but you will be responsible to find parking prior to the start of the program. The \$30 credit will be included in ONE of the weekly checks. Here are some resources you can use to secure parking:

Required Docs: W9 & Contract Agreement:

You will receive an email from El Toro prior to your start day that will contain a W9 & an El Toro Contractor's Agreement which will need to be e-signed and submitted.
